Dear parishioners,

Today we hear the third of three Gospels in which Jesus instructs his disciples for their mission. First, he called them by name and designated them as his apostles. Then he reminded them not to be afraid of any difficulty they may encounter along the way. Now he explains the conditions and the rewards of following him.

St Francis of Assisi interpreted Jesus' words, "take up your cross and follow after me" as the call to live the evangelical counsels: poverty, chastity, obedience. These three usually take the form of vows professed by religious men and women, forming the basis of "consecrated life."

The call of Jesus is for all Christians, and all of us are consecrated to God in Baptism. The evangelical counsels have value for everyone. We should review our commitments and responsibilities, take a look at our daily way of life, and see how we are living with the mind and heart of Christ. The counsel of *poverty* reminds us that our true riches are the people we love and who have blessed us with their friendship. The counsel of *chastity* calls us to faithfulness in our relationships and respect for the persons of others. The counsel of *obedience* – probably the hardest of the three – reminds us that Christ came among us as a servant, not to do his own will but the will of his Father.

# Parish Prayer & Adoration Time


Please join us in prayer every **Wednesday** from 5 – 6 pm, wherever you are.



# NEWS FROM OUR FOOD PANTRY



Your lose your job. Your hours are cut. You have a baby. A relationship ends. Your car breaks down and you can't get to work. Your disability or social security check doesn't stretch to cover your rent and utilities.

These are some of the realities that bring increasing numbers of neighbors to our Food Pantry or to our St. Vincent De Paul phone lines to ask for help with rent, utilities, car repair, or vouchers for beds, clothing or other furniture.

You pray for the hungry. Then you feed them. That's how prayer Works.



Who are some of the neighbors helped over the past 2 month?

Joyce, who is now back to work as a nurses' aide at a Children's Hospital. She was unable to pay her electric bill while on maternity leave and faces disconnection.

Allen, who fell behind on his rent because he needed to repair his car. He works as a Door Dash driver.

Ben, who works for a contracted food service at a public school. When school closed, he was laid off. He is looking for employment, but is behind on his rent after missing just one paycheck. His earnings are so low that he will never catch up.

Carol, who receives just \$941 per month from SSI. Her monthly rent is \$650 and she cannot pay both utilities and rent in any given month. Her gas is disconnected and she faces disconnection of her Ameren service.
