Eucharistic Revival

Our Mission statement at St Pius includes our commitment to "proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ, [and] foster spiritual growth." As we continue on our journey of faith and service we have the opportunity to foster spiritual growth as part of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, who has joined with other dioceses across the country for a Eucharistic Revival.

The revival "is a beautiful invitation to grow in our living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist; to experience His love and mercy; and to share that love and mercy with the world," said Archbishop Mitchell T. Rozanski. The U.S. bishops believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist — and sent out in mission "for the life of the world."

Eucharistic adoration is a powerful prayer that can deepen our experience of Christ's love and mercy in our lives. Recently, Pope Francis urged "the prayer of adoration" to recover the taste and passion for spreading the Good News of the gospel.

There are opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration at both St. Pius Church and St Vincent Church.

St. Vincent DePaul	Friday afternoons from the conclusion of noon Mass until 6pm

Through their prayers, those who "attend" the Blessed Sacrament hold vigil and carry the prayers of all of us to the Lord.

There are two essential aspects of being a disciple of Jesus Christ. One is to be with Him. The second is to invite others to follow Him. Pope St. John Paul II encouraged us "to be generous with our time in going to meet Him in adoration."
