Saturday, March 27.

4:00 – 5:00 PM Church open for prayer

4:00 – 4:30 PM Confessions

4:30 PM Communion Service, including the blessing of palms.
Gospel of the Lord's Entrance into Jerusalem.

Sunday, March 28.

On this day, we recall the Entrance of our Lord Jesus into Jerusalem with the blessing of palm branches.

At each Mass we proclaim the Gospel of our Lord's Passion and Death

8:00 AM Mass (recited)

10:00 AM Mass with music

12:00 Noon Burmese Mass

Blessed palms will also be available outside of Church throughout the day.



Holy Thursday, April 1

7:30 PM:

Liturgy of the Lord's Passion, with music.

For the Adoration of the Cross, please maintain social distance, and show reverence to the Cross without touching it in any way.

The Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil in the Holy Night

April 3, 8:00 PM



Join us as we celebrate our Lord's Resurrection in the most solemn liturgy of the year.

We will bless the new fire, and the Paschal Candle.

We will listen to the story of our salvation, proclaimed in seven readings from the Old Testament, and the Epistle and Gospel.

Water will be blessed for the renewal of Baptismal Promises, and the first Eucharist of Easter will be celebrated.

Father Paul Niemann will be the celebrant. Deacon Patrick McCrudden will be the homilist.

Blessed water will be available for home use.
